



CHANGES TO OUR LECTURE FEEDBACK SYSTEM

From September 2019, we are moving from a voting system using email-addresses to one which uses a password.

This will mean less work for our Membership Secretary, who will no longer need to maintain an additional database of email addresses. It will also mean one less Data Protection issue for our Society.

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY – ESPECIALLY COUPLES WHO ARE BOTH SOCIETY MEMBERS

- When you submit your votes after a lecture, you will NOT be asked to enter your email address. Instead you will be asked to ‘**Enter your password**’.
- The password for all members is **townhall** (all lower case, no space). Type this in.
